Summary

The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development - Health Division (OECD-HD) and the Nuclear Energy Agency (NEA) will present on the findings of recent joint work performed for the HLG-MR on health economics aspects of the medical isotopes supply chain (in particular $^{99}\text{Mo}/^{99\text{m}}\text{Tc}$) that are important in ensuring a long term economically sustainable market model.
